



Summer Term Quarantine

Information for arrivals between 5 - 7 April 2021



We are very much looking forward to welcoming you to Stonar in preparation for the start of the Summer Term. You will be resident in one of our boarding house for the 10 day quarantine period.

We have arranged for a lovely team of Stonar staff to look after you during your stay. You will have access to the house gardens, as well as the common room and kitchen areas. If you are new to the school you will be shown around the house and the communal areas and staff will be on hand to answer any questions you may have. The team will help you access the Wi-Fi and get online so that you can keep in touch with family and friends.

Our experiences during recent months suggest that a daily routine is important to the mental and physical wellbeing of children. The staff will run a routine that allows for exercise, outside time and relaxation.

In addition to the team looking after you, senior staff and our Lead Nurse Practitioner are resident onsite and available should there be any worries or concerns.

Testing

All pupils will be tested on arrival with a lateral flow test and subsequent testing will depend on the restrictions in place at the time of travel and current school policies. Based on current guidance it is necessary to take a Covid test and get a negative result during the three days before travel, as well as purchasing two PCR tests which will be delivered to the School and taken on or before day 2 and on or after day 8 of quarantine.

Quarantine Information	
Will I have a room on my own for quarantine?	No, you will share with one other pupil.
Will I get to talk to other pupils?	You will be forming a 'family bubble'. This means that you will be able to interact and socialise with one another during quarantine.
Do we wear face masks?	Pupils and staff are required to wear facemasks when in communal areas.
	You can remove your masks to eat when in communal areas and outside.
	You do not need to wear a mask when in your own room.
	Pupils may bring their own face masks to school, but school will also provide face masks for the pupils.
Will I have to stay in my room at all times?	No. You can use the common room and kitchen, you will also have access to the house garden. Supervised walks onsite will be possible too.
Will I have access to the internet and computers?	WiFi is available in dorms and communal spaces. You may use your own devices and mobile phones and there are a number of computers in the common room. The WiFi does go off at night, but devices will not be collected in during quarantine.
Where will I eat my meals?	Meals will be provided in house. You will be offered a choice of meals from a menu designed by our Head Chef especially for the quarantine period. A variety of snacks and fresh fruit will be available in the house kitchen too.



What will my daily routine be?	You will receive a welcome booklet when you arrive. This booklet will include timings about the structure of the day, for example when you will need to be out of bed, roll call timings / check ins with the staff on duty, mealtimes, study times etc. We will also let you know when you need to be out of your rooms so our domestic staff can clean.
When will I need to go to bed?	Bedtimes will be as per the usual school timings and are different for different aged students.
What happens with bedding and laundry?	Bedding is provided and our school laundry is operating. We will provide a twice weekly laundry service.
What do I wear?	You can wear your own clothes (mufti). You will need to change out of you sleepwear before you enter the communal areas.
What if I feel ill?	If you don't feel well, speak to the member of staff on duty. If you have symptoms of COVID 19 you will be taken to the Health & Wellbeing Centre where we will arrange for testing and we have procedures in place to support you and the other pupils in the house.
	Our school nurse lives on site and is part of the team looking after you.
