## **Continuity of education:**

Today you will receive information about how we will provide a continuity in the children's education should they be unable to attend school due to illness or isolation or in the event of school closure.

**Reception, Years One and Two -** parents will receive login details for Tapestry via email.

**Years Three, Four, Five and Six –** parents will receive paper login details for Show My Homework if the child is in school and an email if your child is not in school.

Tutors have been teaching the children in Years Three to Six how to use Show My Homework (SMHW) so they are prepared to access learning at home.

I am expecting there to be both technical and human obstacles as we all get used to a new way of working, but please continue to ask and we will support you.

## Staff absences:

I am aware that some schools have been forced to close because of staff absences. We are still open and we are well-staffed and able to run a normal school day of lessons and clubs. This is a fast-moving picture, but that is where we are today.

In the event of staff absence, we may have to combine classes and adjust the timetable to ensure the best possible provision for all our children.
